<u>Directive 2004/52/EC</u> of the European Parliament and of the Council of 29 April 2004 on the *interoperability of electronic road toll systems* in the Community

Article 1 - Objective and scope

(...) It applies to the electronic collection of all types of road fees, on the entire Community road network, urban and interurban, motorways, major and minor roads, and various structures such as tunnels, bridges and ferries.

Article 4 - Features of the European electronic toll service
The decisions relating to the definition of the European electronic toll service shall be taken by the Commission (...) by 1 July 2006.

Commission <u>Decision 2009/750/EC</u> of 6 October 2009 on the definition of the *European Electronic Toll Service* and its technical elements

Article 1 - Subject matter and scope

This Decision defines the European Electronic Toll Service (EETS). It sets out the necessary technical specifications and requirements for that purpose, and contractual rules relating to EETS provision. This Decision lays down rights and obligations on EETS Providers, Toll Chargers and EETS Users.

Article 17 - Notified bodies

Member States shall notify to the Commission and the other Member States any bodies entitled to carry out or supervise the procedure for the assessment of *conformity to specifications* or *suitability for use* referred to in <u>Annex IV</u>, indicating each body's area of competence, and the identification numbers obtained in advance from the Commission. (...)



Decision 2009/750/EC on EETS

<u>ANNEX IV</u> - Conformity to specifications and suitability for use of interoperability constituents - 'EC' Declarations

- 1. Conformity to specifications
- (...) Depending on the chosen conformity assessment modules of Decision No 768/2008/EC, the 'EC' declaration of conformity to specifications covers the manufacturer's self-assessment or the assessment by a <u>notified body</u> (...)
- 2. Suitability for use (interoperability of service)
- (...) the <u>notified body</u> shall (...) assess the in-service interoperability with Toll Charger(s) systems and operational processes;

<u>ANNEX V</u> - Minimum criteria which must be taken into account by Member States when notifying bodies

(a) The body shall be accredited according to the EN 45000 series of standards.



IMQ steps for involvement in EETS as NB

- i. Definition of the <u>organizational structure</u>:
 - certification unit and review and decision responsibility;
 - ii. commercial unit;
 - iii. technical unit (laboratory and technicians for inspections).
- ii. Definition of the internal procedure to carry out the activities.
- iii. Definition of the personnel qualification process.
- iv. Definition of the <u>rules</u> for the customers, the forms, the content of the certificate, etc.
- v. Filling in ACCREDIA documentation to apply for accreditation.
- vi. Application for Ministerial approval for notification.
- vii. Participation in coordination groups at European level.

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

Some feedback of a CAB involved in accreditation process for notification

from 1st January 2010: Reg. 765 shall apply!

Regulation (EC) No 765/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 setting out the requirements for accreditation and (...)

Article 8 - Requirements for national accreditation bodies

- (...) *independent* of the CABs
- (...) ensure that no conflicts of interest with CABs occur
- (...) safeguard the *objectivity* and *impartiality* of its activities
- (...) each decision is taken by *competent* persons different from those who carried out the assessment
- (...) unnecessary *burdens* are not imposed on undertakings

Some feedback of a CAB involved in accreditation process for notification

<u>Decision No 768/2008/EC</u> of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 on a common framework for the marketing of products (...)

Article R23 - Notification procedure

Where a notification is not based on an accreditation certificate (...) shall provide (...) with documentary evidence which attests to the conformity assessment body's competence (...)

- (...) only where no objections are raised by the Commission or the other Member States
- -within <u>two weeks</u> of a notification where an accreditation certificate is used or
- within <u>two months</u> of a notification where accreditation is not used.
