ISO 17021-1 2015 clause 8.2.2 a refers to " any sites within the scope of a multi-site certification ". By definition, multi-site certification is permanent site. This may be interpreted under various context and also involve reissue of certification documents every time a temporary site is completed or a new site is initiated. IAF MD 1 also refers to site, which by definition, are permanent sites and temporary sites to be included if they are so requested by client to be included in scope)
